The consumer is responsible for hiring, training, firing, and managing home health assistants, but the program will handle the payroll for the home health assistant including withholding taxes. In order to receive this assistance, individuals must be qualified through the local Department of Social Security for long term care Medicaid assistance in one of the counties served.
